In a season that comes with an over \$100,000 expense budget, the majority of this cost is funded by the players. We do receive some support from the University Club Sports program, and the Student Senate Association. However, the estimated \$2,500/player fee can be significant when the student is already trying to find ways of paying for their college education. Therefore, part of the players' responsibilities are to help earn extra funds to help cover our seasonal costs. As a team, we perform many activities that help us earn some of





these funds. If you are a professional sports fan, you will see the UNC Bears at many Avalanche and Nuggets games working the 50/50 CAHA Raffle.

Our goal is to provide these studentathletes an experience like any of the major NCAA Hockey programs, with proper uniforms and equipment, a prostyle locker room, and opportunities to give back to the local community, charities, and support of the local youth hockey program, the Greeley Jr. Bears.


UNC Bears receive ACHA DII Divisional Community Service Award 2016-2017
