GREELEY, CO -

The Bears will carry 25 players on their roster for the 2019-20 season. There will be 22 rostered skaters and three rostered goalies.

Even with losing their top two scorers from last season, the Bears' roster is loaded with experience. This year's team returns ten seniors, including six of whom have played in over 100 games with the team. Up front, the Bears will rely on seniors Truman Gonzales and Brantt Heble, both of whom recorded double-digit goal tallies last season. They also bring back their core group of defensemen, highlighted by Chase Upson, Tim Knudson, and Michael Viera who all took fewer than 30 penalty minutes a piece across 36 games.

In other returning news, sophomore Scott Robinson will play more defense, his natural position, this season. Robinson was a converted forward who was limited to just seven games last year after ankle injuries. Additionally, junior Mitch Porter will move to the forward position permanently after splitting 23 games between wing and defense. Finally, senior Sean Cuscaden is primed to step into the starting job in net as the only returning goaltender from last season's squad.

The Bears welcome six new players to the roster for 2019-20, including two true freshman and a DIII transfer. Freshman Jonathan Broadribb has two years of junior hockey experience prior to joining the squad and forward Jaden Opperman played four years of varsity hockey at Columbine High School. Junior forward John Meakins transfers in from ACHA DIII UC-Colorado Springs, where he recorded six points across five games.

The Bears will return all three members of their coaching staff, with head coach Ken Fikis behind the bench for his sixth year with the team. Also rejoining the staff will be assistant coaches Ryan Kenney and Corbin Fitzgibbons.

The Bears begin their 2019-20 season on Friday, September 20th versus the University of Colorado. Puck drop is at 8:30 PM at the Greeley Ice Haus and will also be broadcast on Black Dog Hockey.
