



University of N. Colorado Men's Ice Hockey 2016-'17

1. The UNC Bears returned to the ACHA Div.II league this past season, there are 200+ teams nationally. Last season we finished #6 in the ACHA DIV.II West region, and competed at the West Regional Tournament in UT.
2. We play approx. 38 games, and practice 2-3x weekly throughout the year. We have 3 road trips planned for this coming season – Utah, Idaho and Illinois. Our home games are played at the Greeley Ice Haus in Greeley CO, a single sheet complex that holds 1,000 fans and is located about 5 minutes from campus. The team has its own private locker room, and we average over 600 fans per game, with complete sell-outs (1,200+) vs rivals like Colorado State and U of Wyoming. Cost to play for the team is approx. \$1,200 per semester, which covers all travel expenses (except food), ice times, most team gear, etc. The ACHA Div.II National Tournament in 2016-'17 will be in Ann Arbor, MI (hosted by U. of Michigan).
3. The University of N. Colorado is located on 260 acres of land in the heart of Greeley CO. You'll choose from more than 100 undergraduate or 100-plus graduate programs of study offered by six colleges that include a nationally recognized business school, innovative health and human science programs and award-winning theater arts and teacher education programs. UNC is known for its programs in Business Administration, Dietetics, Journalism, Education, and Sports & Exercise Science. Campus enrollment is approximately 12,800, and the University website is www.unco.edu. It is also a very affordable institution (2015-16 Tuition for full-time Residents was \$6,072 / for full-time Non-Residents \$17,118), with small class sizes and first-rate facilities. UNC participates in the Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) program, offering a reduced tuition rate (\$11,910) to eligible applicants from the 13 western states. As well, Financial Aid, Grants, and Academic Scholarships can be applied for.
4. Speaking of Greeley, it is home to almost 100,000 residents and only 1 hour north of Denver. It has over 34 parks and the Poudre River trail, and is also home to the world famous Greeley Stampede. During their time off, our players are able to head to the mountains for skiing, snowboarding, etc., everything that Colorado has to offer!
